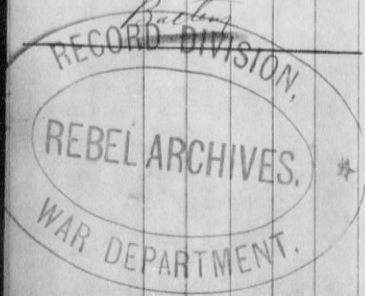

1864. by Parkers Light

Camp of Marion Light Artillery
Church Flats
Feb. 24th 1864.

At a meeting of the members of the
Marion Light Artillery, held at Church
Flats Feb. 24th 1864; the following preamble
and resolutions were unanimously adopted.

Whereas: As members of the Marion
Light Artillery, long since enlisted
for the war, we deem it a pleasure, at
this time to greet in fellowship our
patriot brethren, who with hearts
full of love for our cause, and arms
nerved with determination to clear
their way to an honorable peace, are
re-enlisting with one accord from
Virginia to the far West.

Be it therefore

Resolved: That we hail with delight
as a harbinger of victory, the noble

spirit which, ^{now} animates these war
worn veterans, who far from being and
comfort are cheerfully bearing their
burden anew in a cause they love.

Resolved: That we here willingly and
unanimously, renew our vows to serve
our sold ~~in~~ beloved country, with
for her, the olive branch of peace be
wreathed with the laurel of success.
