The 3d (Brazelton's) Battalion Tennessee Cavalry was organized in 1861 for twelve months and was also called the 2d and the 5th Battalion Tennessee Cavalry. It was re-organized May 12, 1862, and officially recognized as the 14th (Carter's) Battalion Tennessee Cavalry. It was increased to a regiment November 14, 1862, by the addition of other companies and became the 1st (Carter's) Regiment Tennessee Cavalry.
