 a private of Captain John D. Fry's Co. (C) Seventh Reg-  
 iment Iowa "Vol", born in Chinnock Co. in the  
 State of Tennessee, aged 21 years, five feet, six inches  
 high, fair complexion, blue eyes, light hair, and  
 by occupation a farmer, was enlisted at Gallatin  
 on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1861 by J. Boyce to serve  
 one year, and recruited at Colton on the 26<sup>th</sup>  
 day of April 1862, by Capt J. D. Fry to serve for two  
 years on the war, and died from wound on the  
 day of \_\_\_\_\_ 1862. Died at Delmar Md. of disease.

The said Joe Lovell was last paid by S. P. McArthur  
 to me on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of Dec. 1861, and has pay due
