I certify on honor that the above account is correct and just; that the said horse, of private *Helron M. Daniel* of Company *(9)* of *3<sup>d</sup> Tenn* Regiment cavalry, was regularly mustered into the service of the Confederate States, by *Dr Swanson* at *Rogersville Tenn* on the *7<sup>th</sup>* day of *July* 1862, and were valued at *One hundred and fifty* Dollars, and cents, as appears upon the Company Book, and that the said horse was killed in action with the enemy at *Dover Tenn* on the *3<sup>d</sup>* day of *Feb* 1863.
