I certify on honor that the above account is correct and just; that the said horse, of private Helven M. Daniel of Company (G) of 3^d Tenn Regiment cavalry, was regularly mustered into the service of the Confederate States, by Dr Swanson at Rogersville Tenn on the 2^d day of July 1862, and were valued at One hundred and fifty dollars, and cents, as appears upon the Company Book, and that the said horse was killed in action with the enemy at Dover Tenn on the 3^d day of Feb 1863.
