The 25th (also known as Heck's) Regiment Virginia Infantry was accepted into the service of the Confederate States July 1, 1861, with ten companies, A to K. (1st) Company was broken up after its capture and parole at Rich Mountain, Va., in July, 1861. (1st) Companies E, F, H, and I were transferred to the 62d Regiment Virginia Mounted Infantry as Companies I, F, H, and A, respectively, about January 26, 1862. (1st) Company K was assigned to the 62d Regiment Virginia Mounted Infantry, as Company I, September 24, 1862, and subsequently to the 19th Regiment Virginia Cavalry, as (2d) Company K. The regiment was reorganized May 1, 1862, when the four companies of the 9th Battalion Virginia Infantry were assigned to it as (2d) Companies A, C, G, and I. (1st) Companies A, B, C, and D of the regiment became (2d) Companies D, H, D, and F, respectively; (2d) Company E was made up of recruits and transfers from other companies of the regiment; (2d) Company K was formerly (1st) Company D, 21st Regiment Virginia Infantry.
