The 11th Regiment Louisiana Infantry was disbanded by authority of the Secretary of War and in obedience to Special Orders No. 3, dated Headquarters Left Wing A. M., Chattanooga, August 19, 1862. Companies C, D, E, F and G were assigned to the 13th Regiment Louisiana Infantry, Companies A, B, H, I and K to the 20th Regiment Louisiana Infantry, and a number of picked men were organized into a Battalion of Sharp Shooters which was known as the 14th (Austin's) Battalion Louisiana Sharp Shooters.
