*This company was known at various times as Captain Yant's Company, Company G and Company D, 8th Regiment Tennessee Infantry.

The 8th Regiment Tennessee Infantry was organized for State service May 29, 1861; mustered into the service of the Confederate States August 31, 1861, and re-organized May 8, 1862.

About April 9, 1863, the 1st, 6th, 8th, 9th, 16th, 27th, 28th and 34th Regiments Tennessee Infantry and the 24th Battalion Tennessee Sharp Shooters were consolidated and formed the 1st Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry, which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1865.

that he will never be able to perform the duties of
a Soldier and would recommend that he be
discharged from the service.
