The records show that Thomas J. Hines, a private of Company D, 36th Regiment Virginia Infantry (Pittsylvania Regiment), Confederate States Army, enlisted 25 June 1861 at Richmond, Virginia. The company muster roll dated 25 February 1865, latest on file, shows him present.

He was surrendered by General Robert E. Lee, Confederate States Army and paroled 9 April 1865 at Appomattox Court House, Virginia.
