The eligibility dates for war service are the dates determined by the American Legion which are: World War I, April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918; World War II, December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946; Korean War, June 25, 1950 – January 31, 1955; Viet Nam War, December 22, 1961 – May 7, 1975; Lebanon and Grenada, August 24, 1982 – July 31, 1984; Panama, December 20, 1989 – January 31, 1990; Persian Gulf, Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm, August 2, 1990 – May 1, 2003; Operation Enduring Freedom, Afghanistan, October 7, 2001 – Cessation not yet defined, Operation Iraqi Freedom, March 19, 2003 - Cessation not yet defined.
